

What To Expect

Presentation (1 hour)

- ◆ View a power point slide show explaining the history, types and step-by-step process of a typical flight.
- ◆ Learn about each part of the balloon and its function.
- ◆ Students will view the basket, burners and essential instruments needed for flight.
 - Outdoor presentations can include a pilot demonstration of the burner system

Cold Air Inflation (30 minutes)

- ◆ Using fans, students will have the unique experience of being inside an inflated envelope and experience its vast size and design.



Hot Air Inflation (30 minutes)

- ◆ A sequential demonstration of inflating a balloon to the point of buoyancy.
